JOIN US IN PRAYER FOR THE GROVE

YOUNG ADULTS MIAMI MISSION TRIP | MAY 7TH-12TH

During the month of May, our college and young adult ministry, The Grove, will be going to Miami for Send South Florida. Why Send South Florida? Over 5.6 million people live and work in Metro Miami, of that population only 11.4% claim an affiliation with an evangelical church. Additionally, 61.9% claim no affiliation with any religious body. Our team will be working directly in the Miami Metro area with three North American Mission Board church planters. Each of these planters' context are vastly different even though they all serve within 45 minutes of each other. Eric Bancroft, one of the NAMB church planters, shared that he is planting what will be the only evangelical church within his two square mile area. That doesn't sound like a big deal from our context of the panhandle where in Santa Rosa County our population density is 116 people and in the Milton area 720 people per square mile. However, for Eric, there is an estimated 43,000 people living within the first square mile of his plant. That number represents: Brazilians, Cubans, Haitians, Russians and more. None of which has direct access to an evangelical church, much less a Southern Baptist Church. Jesus' words in Acts 1:8 hold very true for us reaching the ends of the earth with the gospel. Please pray for our team and church planters like Eric as we reach the nations without having to leave the state of Florida.
